### Classes and courses

How to read this chart: Classes for the Texas Championships will be similar (but not identical) to those of national orienteering events. Blue boxes indicate courses and classes eligible for the Texas Champion designation: First place will receive a special medal, while 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places receive NTOA medals.

Yellow boxes indicate non-Championship classes. Top three finishers receive NTOA medals. White boxes indicate classes where no awards will be given.
