Tyler State Park

April 13, 2024

Welcome to NTOA's annual April meet at beautiful Tyler State Park. Carl Bridges has worked hard on designing a set of challenging courses. There are some slight changes from years past. So, please read carefully.

Park Entrance Fee

1. There is an entrance fee for each person as you enter the park. It is \$6/per person age 13+. Kids 12 and under are free.
2. School groups may qualify for a discount. Please call the park at 1-903-597-5338 to make arrangements.

Registration

We will once again use the large group pavilion as we have in previous years for our Headquarters, Registration and e-punch downloading. Please don't park in the lot in front of the pavilion unless you're a meet volunteer. See info on parking below.

Start and Finish

Start will be a ~15-minute walk from the HQ pavilion where an old truck road intersects the Park Road on the northwest side of the park. Course Setter notes will include the exact location.

Finish will be near the HQ pavilion.

Parking

Buses: We will use the large parking lot at the boat ramp that is about 200 meters north of the group pavilion. Buses can drop off participants near the pavilion, but please then follow signage to the parking area.

Cars: There is parking at the boat ramp, but buses have priority here. You can fill in where you can. Otherwise, there is parking in other areas, such as also the boat house where the bathrooms are. Parking is also available at the long parking area that parallels the lake near the Finish. So, you may park here and have your car there.

Restrooms

There are restrooms at the bath house area. There are also facilities located near the campgrounds throughout the park.

Assisting School

If your group can help, please contact me at the email below ASAP, and thank you! There is an honorarium paid for helping, more if you can help pick up bags.

Finally: Some areas of the park are marked as “Out of Bounds.” This includes camping grounds that are marked by red stripes on the map. Do not go into these areas. Otherwise, please be respectful of others and pick up after yourself if you bring in water, etc.
